

Gingerbread Man Pattern



Skill Level: Easy

What you will need

- brown, red, green, and white #4 worsted weight (10ply, Aran) yarn
- Scissors
- Large eye yarn needle
- Safety pin or stitch marker
- 3.5mm crochet hook
- black embroidery thread
- polyester stuffing

US Terms

Single Crochet sc

Slip Stitch sl st

Decrease dec.

single crochet 2 stitches together

Increase inc.

work 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch

Sample Round: *sc 1x, inc* 6x (18)

Explanation: *Single crochet 1 time, increase by working 2 single crochets in the next stitch* repeat section between * * 6 times (you will have a total of 18 stitches for this round)

Head

Rnd. 1: Make adjustable ring (6)

Rnd. 2: *sc 2x in each stitch* (12)

Rnd. 3: *sc 1x, inc* 6x (18)

Rnd. 4: *sc 2x, inc* 6x (24)

Rnd. 5: *sc 3x, inc* 6x (30)

Rnd. 6-10: sc in each stitch (30)

Rnd. 11: *sc 3x, dec* 6x (24)

Rnd. 12: *sc 2x, dec* 6x (18)

-stuff firmly-

Rnd. 13: *sc 1x, dec* 6x (12)

Rnd. 14: (dec) 2x only and end-partial row (10)

slip stitch, pull yarn thru the stitch
leaving a long tail



Leg 1

Rnd. 1: Make adjustable ring (6)

Rnd. 2: *sc 2x in each stitch* (12)

Rnd. 3-11: sc in each stitch (12)

slip stitch, pull yarn thru leaving a long tail
-stuff-

Leg 2

Rnd. 1: Make adjustable ring (6)

Rnd. 2: *sc 2x in each stitch* (12)

Rnd. 3-11: sc in each stitch (12)

-line up the slip stitch from leg 1 with your next stitch, Rnd. 11 will join the legs, work around leg 1
and then continue around leg 2.

Rnd. 12-19: sc in each stitch (24)

-stuff

Rnd. 20: *sc 2x, dec* 6x (18)

Rnd. 21: *sc 1x, dec* 6x (12)

Rnd. 22: (dec) 2x only – partial row (10)

Rnd. 23-26: sc in each stitch

-This neck will be inserted into the head

slip stitch, pull yarn thru the stitch leaving
a long tail



Arms (make 2)

Rnd. 1: Make adjustable ring (6)

Rnd. 2: *sc 2x in each stitch* (12)

Rnd. 3-9: sc in each stitch (12)

-stuff

Rnd. 10: (dec) 3x only- partial row (9)

slip stitch, pull yarn thru the stitch
leaving a long tail

- Using the long tails sew the arms to the body.
- Insert the neck into the head opening and sew around the edge to secure.



Bow Tie

Worked Flat

Chain 6, turn

Row. 1: Sc in 2nd stitch, sc in each stitch across, turn (5)

Row. 2- 4: Chain 1, sc in each stitch across, turn (5)

Slip stitch and use the long tail to sew the center of the rectangle to the front of the Gingerbread Man. Stitch around the center and pull tight so the rectangle dips in, this will help it look like a bow.

Hat

Rnd. 1: Make adjustable ring (5)

Rnd. 2: sc in each stitch (5)

Rnd. 3: *sc 1x, inc* 2x, sc last stitch (7)

Rnd. 4: *sc 1x, inc* 3x, sc last stitch (10)

Rnd. 5: *sc 2x, inc* 3x, sc last stitch (13)

Rnd. 6: sc in each stitch (13)

Rnd. 7: *sc 1x, sc 3x in next stitch* 3x, sc last stitch (16)

Rnd. 8: sc in each stitch (16)

Rnd. 9: *sc 2x, inc* 5x, sc last stitch (21)

Rnd. 10: *sc 3x, inc* 5x, sc last stitch (26)

Rnd. 11: *sc 4x, inc* 5x, sc last stitch (31)

-change to white yarn

Rnd. 12: sc in each stitch (31)

Slip stitch and pull yarn through leaving a long tail for sewing

-Stitch the hat to the head using the white tail, then bend the point of the hat over and stitch in place. Stitch around the point several times to create a large white Puff.



- Using white yarn stitch zig zag designs on the hands and feet, and two buttons on the chest.
- using black embroidery thread stitch a smile.
- using black embroidery thread create French knots for each eye.
