The Easiest Hat Ever Crochet Pattern

This easy hat has a ribbed texture, and is made with #5 bulky yarn.

It is made from a rectangle of double crochet rows. Once complete, join the first and last rows of the rectangle into a tube and slip stitch the two edges together.

Adult size will fit a 20 to 23 inch head (9 years and up)

Child size will fit a 18 to 20 inch head (5 to 8 years)

Supplies:

- 2 skeins of any #5 bulky yarn
- 5 mm crochet hook
- 3 inch puff for the top

US Terms:

Chain (ch)
Slip Stitch (sl st)

Double Crochet, back loop only (dc blo)

Double Crochet in the back loop only (dc blo)



Gauge:

4"x4" = 6 rows x 14 dc blo stitches

Pattern:

Adult chain 42 stitches (40 plus 2 turning chains)

Child chain 34 stitches (32 plus 2 turning chains)

Row 1: begin in 3rd chain from hook, double crochet in the back loop only of each chain, turn (40 A) or (32 C)

Row 2: chain 2, double crochet in the back loop only of each stitch, turn (40 A) or (32 C)



For Adult repeat pattern for Rows 3-32: chain 2, dc blo in each stitch (40) For Child repeat pattern for Rows 3-28: chain 2, dc blo in each stitch (32)



Fold the rectangle in half and slip stitch the first and last rows together to form a tube





-slip stitch to end of the row and pull the yarn thru, leave a long tail for sewing -using a long running stitch sew around the top edge to gather the top of the hat



-stitch whatever puff you desire to the top and you're done!
